- a. **Put off sin and every weight** (Hebrews 12:1)
 - i. Not a sprint but a marathon

 - b. **Jesus rebuked his disciples over provision. Little faith** (Matthew 6:25-34)
 - i. God provided for us yesterday, but we don't have faith for a new day.

 - c. **Jesus rebuked his disciples for fearing the storm. Where is your faith? Why no faith?** (Matthew 8:23-27)
 - i. Jesus was asleep because He knew that no storm was going to stop Him from getting to the other side. We need to know when to rebuke a storm and when to rest through it.

 - d. Jesus rebuked his disciples for forgetting the recent past of feeding the multitudes. **Little faith** (Matthew 16:5-12)
 - i. Once again our stomachs get in the way of trusting God with our daily provision. We want Manna for the whole week.

 - e. Jesus rebuked the 11 disciples for **unbelief & hardness of heart** concerning the gospel from others. (Mark 16:14)
 - i. Jesus then told them to go into all the world. Wow!

 - f. Corrected Thomas for being **faithless** without seeing. (John 20:24-27)
 - i. Thomas refused to believe without touching His wounds.

 - g. Rebuking a **perverse and faithless generation**, and **unbelief in disciples**
 - i. (Matthew 17:17, 20)

 - h. **Road to Emmaus, Slow to believe** (Luke 24:25)
 - i. How much do you need to know to believe?
 - ii. Always learning but never coming to the truth
 - iii. Faith always requires unanswered questions

 - i. **Faith to faithful to faith running over**
 - i. Faith must endure until the request is received
